GUIDE FOR REVIEWERS:

Philostrato Revista de Historia y Arte, provides the reviewers with a standardized form to stick to, although the submission of a free report is also accepted in both cases they will be used the next guidelines:

- The reviewers will decline to participate in the review of a work if there is a conflict of interest or if they believe that the issue does not fit their abilities. This must be recorded on the form and therefore the review will not begin.
- The reviewers will never show or discuss with third parts the works they are reviewing, nor the conclusions.
- The reviewers will conduct an independent and objective review of the work, always based on respect, constructive and argued criticism.
- Notes, citations and bibliography will also be subject to revision, emphasizing its updating and availability.
- It will be reviewed that the conclusions are true and relevant to the subject matter of the work.
- For the correct functioning of the editorial process, it is necessary to comply with the deadlines given by the editor for the reviews (3 weeks) but in special cases this period may be extended.
